**SENATE AMENDMENT 5,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 40**

June 20, 2013 – Offered by Senators C. LARSON, RISSER, WIRCH, T. CULLEN, MILLER, LEHMAN, SHILLING, HARRIS, VINEHOUT, L. TAYLOR, LASSA and SCHULTZ.

- 1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute  
2           amendment 1, as follows:
- 3           **1.** Page 138, line 4: delete “and other school districts”.
  - 4           **2.** Page 140, line 20: delete “and other school”.
  - 5           **3.** Page 140, line 21: delete “districts”.
  - 6           **4.** Page 141, line 4: delete “and other school districts”.
  - 7           **5.** Page 322, line 20: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
8           with page 323, line 2, as affected by assembly amendment 3.
  - 9           **6.** Page 324, line 8: delete lines 8 to 15, as affected by assembly amendment  
10          3.
  - 11          **7.** Page 981, line 24: delete that line.

1           **8.** Page 982, line 1: delete lines 1 to 20, as affected by assembly amendment

2           3.

3           **9.** Page 982, line 22: delete “and c.”.

4           **10.** Page 983, line 4: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
5 with page 984, line 10, as affected by assembly amendment 3.

6           **11.** Page 985, line 24: delete that line.

7           **12.** Page 986, line 1: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
8 with page 987, line 15, as affected by assembly amendment 3, as affected by assembly  
9 amendment 1, thereto, and including the material inserted by assembly amendment  
10 3, as affected by assembly amendment 1, thereto, and substitute:

11           “**SECTION 1847m.** 118.60 (3) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 118.60 (3) (a)  
12 (intro.) and amended to read:

13           118.60 (3) (a) (intro.) The pupil or the pupil’s parent or guardian shall submit  
14 an application, on a form provided by the state superintendent, to the participating  
15 private school that the pupil wishes to attend. If more than one pupil from the same  
16 family applies to attend the same private school, the pupils may use a single  
17 application. Within 60 days after receiving the application, the private school shall  
18 notify each applicant, in writing, whether his or her application has been accepted.  
19 If the private school rejects an application, the notice shall include the reason. A  
20 private school may reject an applicant only if it has reached its maximum general  
21 capacity or seating capacity. The state superintendent shall ensure that the private  
22 school determines which pupils to accept on a random basis, except that the private  
23 school may give preference in accepting applications to ~~siblings of pupils accepted on~~  
24 ~~a random basis.~~ any of the following:”.

10           **18.** Page 1315, line 13: delete the material beginning with that line and  
11 ending with page 1316, line 9, as affected by assembly amendment 3.
