**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO SENATE BILL 514**

February 14, 2014 – Offered by Senator TIFFANY.

1     **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 350.12 (3) (b); and *to create* 350.12 (3) (b) 2.  
2             of the statutes; **relating to:** registration of antique snowmobiles.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 350.12 (3) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 350.12 (3) (b) 1. and  
4             amended to read:

5             350.12 (3) (b) 1. Any person who is a resident of this state and the owner of a  
6             snowmobile which has a model year of 1966 or earlier may, upon application, register  
7             the snowmobile as an antique snowmobile may register the snowmobile as an  
8             antique snowmobile if it is at least 35 years old at the time that the owner applies  
9             for such registration. Upon payment of a fee of \$20, the applicant owner shall be  
10            furnished a registration certificate and decals of a distinctive design, in lieu of the  
11            design on the decals issued under par. (d). The design shall show that the

1 snowmobile is an antique. The registration shall be valid without payment of any  
2 additional registration fee while the snowmobile is owned by the applicant.  
3 certificate shall be valid for 2 years. If the snowmobile is registered before April 1,  
4 the 2-year period begins on the July 1 before the date of application. If the  
5 snowmobile is registered on or after April 1 of a given year, the 2-year period begins  
6 on the July 1 after the date of application. The fee for issuance of the initial  
7 registration certificate is \$20. The fee for renewal of the registration is \$5.

8 3. Unless inconsistent with this paragraph, the provisions of this chapter  
9 applicable to other snowmobiles shall apply to antique snowmobiles.

10 **SECTION 2.** 350.12 (3) (b) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

11 350.12 (3) (b) 2. An owner who has applied to register a snowmobile under this  
12 paragraph before the effective of this subdivision .... [LRB inserts date], is exempt  
13 from the initial registration requirement under subd.1. if the person submits an  
14 application to renew the registration under subd. 1. before March 1, 2015.
