**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 422**

February 9, 2016 - Offered by Representatives HEBL, POPE, KESSLER, RIEMER, BERCEAU, BILLINGS, OHNSTAD, KOLSTE, SARGENT, SPREITZER, CONSIDINE, MEYERS, BROSTOFF, SINICKI, HESSELBEIN, C. TAYLOR, WACHS, DANOU, SHANKLAND, JORGENSEN, SUBECK, JOHNSON and GOYKE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 3: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 1b.** 27.01 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 27.01 (1) PURPOSE. It is declared to be the policy of the legislature to acquire,  
5 improve, preserve, maintain, provide funding for, and administer a system of areas  
6 to be known as the state parks of Wisconsin. The purpose of the state parks is to  
7 provide areas for public recreation and for public education in conservation and  
8 nature study. An area may qualify as a state park by reason of its scenery, its plants  
9 and wildlife, or its historical, archaeological, or geological interest. The department  
10 shall be responsible for the selection of a balanced system of state park areas and for  
11 the acquisition, development, and administration of the state parks. No admission  
12 charge shall be made to any state park, except as provided in subs. (7) to (9).

1           **SECTION 1c.** 27.01 (7) (f) 1. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
2 55, is amended to read:

3           27.01 (7) (f) 1. Except as provided in par. (gm), the fee for an annual vehicle  
4 admission receipt is ~~\$27.50~~ \$24.50 for each vehicle that has Wisconsin registration  
5 plates, except that no fee is charged for a receipt issued under s. 29.235 (6).

6           **SECTION 1d.** 27.01 (7) (f) 2. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
7 55, is amended to read:

8           27.01 (7) (f) 2. Except as provided in subds. 3. and 4. and par. (gm) 4., the fee  
9 for a daily vehicle admission receipt is ~~\$7.85~~ \$6.85 for any vehicle which has  
10 Wisconsin registration plates.

11           **SECTION 1e.** 27.01 (7) (f) 3. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
12 55, is amended to read:

13           27.01 (7) (f) 3. Subject to par. (gm) 5., the fee for a daily vehicle admission  
14 receipt for a motor bus that has Wisconsin registration plates is ~~\$10.85~~ \$9.85.

15           **SECTION 1f.** 27.01 (7) (g) 1. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
16 55, is amended to read:

17           27.01 (7) (g) 1. Except as provided in par. (gm), the fee for an annual vehicle  
18 admission receipt is ~~\$37.50~~ \$34.50 for any vehicle that has a registration plate or  
19 plates from another state, except that no fee is charged for a receipt issued under s.  
20 29.235 (6).

21           **SECTION 1g.** 27.01 (7) (g) 2. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
22 55, is amended to read:

23           27.01 (7) (g) 2. Except as provided in subds. 3. and 4., the fee for a daily vehicle  
24 admission receipt for any vehicle that has a registration plate or plates from another  
25 state is ~~\$10.85~~ \$9.85.

1           **SECTION 1h.** 27.01 (7) (g) 3. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
2 55, is amended to read:

3           27.01 (7) (g) 3. Subject to par. (gm) 5., the fee for a daily vehicle admission  
4 receipt for a motor bus that has a registration plate or plates from another state is  
5 ~~\$14.85~~ \$13.85.

6           **SECTION 1i.** 27.01 (7) (gm) 1. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
7 55, is amended to read:

8           27.01 (7) (gm) 1. Instead of the fees under pars. (f) 1. and (g) 1., the department  
9 shall charge an individual ~~\$15~~ \$12 or ~~\$20~~ \$17, respectively, for an annual vehicle  
10 admission receipt if the individual applying for the receipt or a member of his or her  
11 household owns a vehicle for which a current annual vehicle admission receipt has  
12 been issued for the applicable fee under par. (f) 1. or (g) 1.

13           **SECTION 1k.** 27.01 (7) (gm) 3. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
14 55, is amended to read:

15           27.01 (7) (gm) 3. Notwithstanding par. (f) 1., the fee for an annual vehicle  
16 admission receipt for a vehicle that has Wisconsin registration plates and that is  
17 owned by a resident senior citizen, as defined in s. 29.001 (72), is ~~\$12.50~~ \$9.50.

18           **SECTION 1L.** 27.01 (8) (c) 1. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
19 55, is renumbered 27.01 (8) (c) and amended to read:

20           27.01 (8) (c) The department may establish by rule the amount of the admission  
21 fee to enter Heritage Hill state park or a state trail.

22           **SECTION 1m.** 27.01 (8) (c) 2. of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
23 55, is repealed.

24           **SECTION 1n.** 27.01 (8) (c) 3. of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
25 55, is repealed.

1           **SECTION 1p.** 27.01 (10) (d) 1. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
2 55, is amended to read:

3           27.01 (10) (d) 1. ~~The department shall charge a camping fee of not less than \$15~~  
4 ~~but not more than \$20, as determined by the secretary, for each night at a campsite~~  
5 ~~in a state campground that is classified as a Type “A” campground by the department~~  
6 ~~is \$10 for a resident camping party, except as provided under par. (fm).~~

7           **SECTION 1q.** 27.01 (10) (d) 2. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
8 55, is amended to read:

9           27.01 (10) (d) 2. ~~The department shall charge a camping fee of not less than \$19~~  
10 ~~but not more than \$25, as determined by the secretary, for each night at a campsite~~  
11 ~~in a state campground that is classified as a Type “A” campground by the department~~  
12 ~~is \$12 for a nonresident camping party, except as provided under par. (fm).~~

13           **SECTION 1r.** 27.01 (10) (d) 3. of the statutes is created to read:

14           27.01 (10) (d) 3. The camping fee for each night at a campsite in a state  
15 campground that is classified as a Type “B” campground by the department is \$9 for  
16 a resident camping party.

17           **SECTION 1s.** 27.01 (10) (d) 4. of the statutes is created to read:

18           27.01 (10) (d) 4. The camping fee for each night at a campsite in a state  
19 campground that is classified as a Type “B” campground by the department is \$11  
20 for a nonresident camping party.

21           **SECTION 1t.** 27.01 (10) (d) 5. of the statutes is created to read:

22           27.01 (10) (d) 5. The camping fee for each night at a campsite in a campground  
23 that is classified as a Type “C” campground by the department is \$8 for a resident  
24 camping party.

25           **SECTION 1u.** 27.01 (10) (d) 6. of the statutes is created to read:

1 27.01 (10) (d) 6. The camping fee for each night at a campsite in a campground  
2 that is classified as a Type "C" campground by the department is \$10 for a  
3 nonresident camping party.

4 **SECTION 1v.** 27.01 (10) (fm) of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
5 55, is repealed.

6 **SECTION 1w.** 27.01 (10) (g) 2. of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
7 55, is amended to read:

8 27.01 (10) (g) 2. An additional camping fee from \$1.50 to \$1.75, depending on  
9 whether the campground is Type "A," "B," or "C," per night for a nonresident camping  
10 party.

11 **SECTION 1x.** 27.01 (10) (g) 5. of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
12 55, is repealed.

13 **SECTION 1y.** 227.01 (13) (xm) of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin Act  
14 55, is repealed.”.

15 **2.** Page 2, line 14: after that line insert:

16 “(2m) GPR STATE PARKS AND STATE RECREATION AREAS POSITIONS. In the schedule  
17 under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of  
18 natural resources under section 20.370 (1) (ea) of the statutes, as affected by the acts  
19 of 2015, the dollar amount is increased by \$4,668,800 for the second fiscal year of the  
20 fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect to increase the authorized FTE  
21 positions for the department of natural resources by 44.68 GPR state parks and state  
22 recreation areas positions.”.
