**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 92**

April 23, 2015 - Offered by Representatives KULP, JACQUE and SANFELIPPO.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 1: before that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 1c.** 344.14 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 344.14 (2) (d) To any person qualifying as a self-insurer under s. 344.16 or to
5 any person operating a vehicle for such self-insurer or to any member of a religious
6 sect issued a certificate of self-insurance under s. 344.16.

7 **SECTION 1f.** 344.16 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 344.16 (1) (intro.) and
8 amended to read:

9 344.16 (1) (intro.) ~~Any person in whose name more than 25 motor vehicles are~~
10 ~~registered~~ of the following may qualify as a self-insurer by obtaining a certificate of
11 self-insurance issued by the secretary as provided in sub. (2);

12 **SECTION 1i.** 344.16 (1) (a) and (b) of the statutes are created to read:

1 344.16 (1) (a) A person in whose name more than 25 motor vehicles are
2 registered.

3 (b) Subject to sub. (2m), a religious sect the members of which have collectively
4 registered with the department more than 25 motor vehicles.

5 **SECTION 1L.** 344.16 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 344.16 (2) ~~The Subject to sub. (2m), the~~ secretary may, upon the application of
7 such a person or religious sect, issue a certificate of self-insurance when satisfied
8 that such person or religious sect is possessed and will continue to be possessed of
9 ability to pay judgments obtained against such person or religious sect.

10 **SECTION 1o.** 344.16 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

11 344.16 (2m) The secretary may issue a certificate of self-insurance under sub.
12 (2) to a religious sect only if the secretary determines that the members of the
13 religious sect have a long-standing history of mutual financial assistance in time of
14 need to the extent that they share in financial obligations of other members who
15 would otherwise be unable to meet their obligations.”.

16 **2.** Page 5, line 10: after that line insert:

17 “**SECTION 8g.** 344.62 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

18 344.62 (1) Except as provided in s. 344.63, no person may operate a motor
19 vehicle upon a highway or upon premises held out to the public for use of their motor
20 vehicles, premises provided by employers to employees for the use of their motor
21 vehicles, or premises provided to tenants of rental housing in buildings of 4 or more
22 units for the use of their motor vehicles in this state unless the owner or operator of
23 the vehicle has in effect a motor vehicle liability policy with respect to the vehicle
24 being operated.
