15	49.471 (4g) Medicaid expansion; federal medical assistance percentage. (a)
16	For services provided to individuals described under sub. (4) (a) 4. and s. 49.45 (23),
17	the department shall comply with all federal requirements to qualify for the highest
18	available enhanced federal medical assistance percentage. The department shall
19	submit any amendment to the state medical assistance plan, request for a waiver of
20	federal Medicaid law, or other approval required by the federal government to
21	provide services to the individuals described under sub. (4) (a) 4. and s. 49.45 (23) and
22	qualify for the highest available enhanced federal medical assistance percentage.

3	affected by the acts of 2015, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 is decreased
4	by \$102,900,000 to provide Medical Assistance to certain adults with incomes up to
5	133 percent of the federal poverty line. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of
6	the statutes for the appropriation to the department of health services under section
7	20.435 (4) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2015, the dollar amount for
8	fiscal year 2016–17 is decreased by \$220,600,000 to provide Medical Assistance to
9	certain adults with incomes up to 133 percent of the federal poverty line.".
