**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 3**

February 15, 2018 - Offered by Representative SUMMERFIELD.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 21: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 5j.** 49.823 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **49.823 Public benefit database review.** The department of health services
5 and the department of children and families shall, at least once every 3 months,
6 perform a comparison of each department’s respective public benefit database
7 information against nationally recognized databases that contain information on
8 death records, including the federal social security administration’s Death Master
9 File, to identify participants in public benefit programs that are deceased. If a
10 department determines during a review under this section that a participant is
11 deceased, the department shall designate that individual as ineligible for benefits in
12 any applicable database. The requirements under this section do not apply to the

1 department of children and families with regard to child care subsidies under s.
2 49.155.”.
