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## SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 653

February 20, 2018 - Offered by Senators Erpenbach, Carpenter, Vinehout, Johnson, Schachtner and Larson.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 1, line 3: after "tissue" insert ", coverage of supplemental screenings,".
3	<b>2.</b> Page 1, line 4: before that line insert:
4	"SECTION 1d. 40.51 (8m) of the statutes is amended to read:
5	40.51 (8m) Every health care coverage plan offered by the group insurance
6	board under sub. (7) shall comply with ss. $631.95$ , $632.746$ (1) to (8) and (10), $632.747$ ,
7	$632.748,\ 632.798,\ 632.83,\ 632.835,\ 632.85,\ 632.853,\ 632.855,\ 632.867,\ 632.885,$
8	632.89, and 632.895 (8) (cm) and (11) to (17).
9	<b>SECTION 1f.</b> $66.0137(4)$ of the statutes, as affected by 2017 Wisconsin Act 30,
10	is amended to read:
11	66.0137 (4) SELF-INSURED HEALTH PLANS. If a city, including a 1st class city, or
12	a village provides health care benefits under its home rule power, or if a town

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1	provides health care benefits, to its officers and employees on a self-insured basis,
2	the self-insured plan shall comply with ss. $49.493(3)(d)$ , $631.89$ , $631.90$ , $631.93(2)$ ,
3	632.746 (10) (a) 2. and (b) 2., 632.747 (3), 632.798, 632.855, 632.853, 632.855, 632.867,
4	632.87 (4) to (6), 632.885, 632.89, 632.895 (8) (cm) and (9) to (17), 632.896, and
5	767.513 (4).
6	SECTION 1g. 120.13 (2) (g) of the statutes, as affected by 2017 Wisconsin Act 30,
7	is amended to read:
8	120.13 (2) (g) Every self-insured plan under par. (b) shall comply with ss.
9	49.493 (3) (d), 631.89, 631.90, 631.93 (2), 632.746 (10) (a) 2. and (b) 2., 632.747 (3),
10	632.798, 632.85, 632.853, 632.855, 632.867, 632.87 (4) to (6), 632.885, 632.89,
11	632.895 (8) (cm) and (9) to (17), 632.896, and 767.513 (4).".
12	<b>3.</b> Page 2, line 22: after that line insert:
13	"SECTION 2m. 632.895 (8) (cm) of the statutes is created to read:
14	632.895 (8) (cm) Every disability insurance policy and self-insured health
15	plan, as defined in s. 632.745 (24), that provides coverage of a mammogram shall
16	provide coverage for supplemental screenings for any woman covered under the
17	policy or plan who is diagnosed with dense breast tissue, as defined in s. $255.065$ (1)
18	(a).
19	SECTION 3m. Initial applicability.
20	(1) COVERAGE OF SUPPLEMENTAL SCREENING.
21	(a) For policies and plans containing provisions inconsistent with this act, the
22	treatment of sections $40.51 (8m)$ , $66.0137 (4)$ , $120.13 (2) (g)$ , and $632.895 (8) (cm)$ of

23 the statutes first applies to policy or plan years beginning on January 1 of the year

following the year in which this paragraph takes effect, except as provided in
 paragraph (b).

(b) For policies or plans that are affected by a collective bargaining agreement
containing provisions inconsistent with this act, the treatment of sections 40.51
(8m), 66.0137 (4), 120.13 (2) (g), and 632.895 (8) (cm) of the statutes first applies to
policy or plan years beginning on the effective date of this paragraph or on the day
on which the collective bargaining agreement is newly established, extended,
modified, or renewed, whichever is later.

## SECTION 4m. Effective date.

(1) COVERAGE OF SUPPLEMENTAL SCREENING. The treatment of sections 40.51
(8m), 66.0137 (4), 120.13 (2) (g), and 632.895 (8) (cm) of the statutes and SECTION 3m
(1) of this act take effect on the first day of the 4th month beginning after
publication.".
