**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 732**

1 **AN ACT to create** 20.485 (2) (c) and 45.455 of the statutes; **relating to:** a program
2 to provide outreach, support, and mental health and substance abuse services
3 for veterans and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This substitute amendment requires the Department of Veterans Affairs to administer a program to provide outreach, mental health services, and support to certain individuals who are serving or who have served in the armed forces and who have a mental health condition or substance abuse disorder. Under the substitute amendment, DVA must provide quarterly reports to the governor and the Joint Committee on Finance that include the number of individuals served by the program, the services provided to individuals, and the types of insurance held by individuals who receive services under the program.
