SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 11

February 16, 2017 - Offered by Senator KAPENGA.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follow
--

- **1.** Page 2, line 7: after that line insert:
- 3 "Section 1m. 102.60 (1m) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:
 - 102.60 (1m) (c) An amount equal to double the amount recoverable by the injured employee, but not to exceed \$15,000, if the injured employee is a minor of permit age <u>or older</u> and at the time of the injury is employed, required, suffered, or permitted to work at prohibited employment.".
 - **2.** Page 6, line 4: delete lines 4 to 11 and substitute:

"103.75 (1) The department or persons designated by the department may issue certificates of age for minors individuals under rules the department deems necessary. In issuing a certificate of age for a minor, the department or person designated by the department shall accept as evidence of the minor's individual's age the evidence specified in s. 103.73 (1) (a) in the manner specified in s. 103.73 (1) (a).

1	The certificate is conclusive evidence of the age of the minor individual to whom
2	issued in any proceeding under any of the labor laws and under ch. 102 as to any act
3	or thing occurring subsequent to the date the certificate was issued.".
4	3. Page 6, line 14: after "minor" insert "or as to whether an individual is a
5	minor".
6	4. Page 6, line 16: delete "for the minor".
7	5. Page 6, line 23: delete "the minor's" and substitute "the minor's".
8	6. Page 7, line 6: after that line insert:
9	"Section 21m. 103.805 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
10	103.805 (2) The fee for issuance of permits and certificates of age shall be paid
11	by the employer, but when. If the minor individual for whom the permit or certificate
12	is issued advances the fee to the permit officer, the minor individual shall be
13	reimbursed by the minor's employer not later than at the end of the minor's his or
14	<u>her</u> first pay period.".
15	7. Page 8, line 9: after that line insert:
16	"Section 27m. Initial applicability.
17	$(1m)$ The treatment of section $102.60\ (1m)\ (c)$ of the statutes first applies to an
18	injury or death occurring on the effective date of this subsection.".
