**SENATE AMENDMENT 2,
TO SENATE BILL 296**

September 27, 2017 - Offered by Senator DARLING.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 9, line 5: delete lines 5 and 6 and substitute:

3 “(d) The scope of practice for each occupation or profession that the
4 organization certifies and all of the following information about each such scope of
5 practice:”.

6 **2.** Page 10, line 8: after that line insert:

7 “(3m) The department shall forward to the appropriate supporting
8 organization a complaint about an individual who is included in the registry that is
9 related to the individual’s practice of the occupation or profession for which he or she
10 is included in the registry.”.

11 **3.** Page 11, line 24: after “filed.” insert “Notwithstanding s. 227.52, a decision
12 by the secretary under this paragraph is not subject to review under ss. 227.52 to
13 227.58.”.

1 **4.** Page 15, line 10: after that line insert:

2 “(g) The department removes the individual pursuant to s. 475.15 (3) (b) 1.”.

3 **5.** Page 15, line 20: after “**Penalties**” insert “; **enforcement**”.

4 **6.** Page 15, line 25: after that line insert:

5 “(3) (a) The department may do any of the following:

6 1. Assess against an individual who violates s. 475.13 (5) a forfeiture not to
7 exceed \$10,000.

8 2. Assess against an individual who, in an application for inclusion in the
9 registry under s. 475.13 (1) (a) or in a renewal application under s. 475.13 (2) (b),
10 intentionally makes a material misstatement or intentionally submits falsified
11 documentation a forfeiture not to exceed \$1,000.

12 (b) 1. The department shall, after a period prescribed by the department,
13 remove from the registry an individual who is included in the registry and who fails
14 to pay a forfeiture assessed by the department under par. (a) 1. or 2. The individual
15 may again be included in the registry if otherwise eligible upon payment of the
16 forfeiture.

17 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of chs. 440 to 480 relating to issuance
18 or renewal of an initial license, permit, or certificate of certification or registration
19 under chs. 440 to 480, an individual who is assessed a forfeiture by the department
20 under par. (a) 1. or 2. may not be granted an initial license, permit, or certificate of
21 certification or registration under chs. 440 to 480 until he or she has paid the
22 forfeiture.”.

23 **7.** Page 18, line 3: after that line insert:
