2 **1.** Page 6, line 12: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 8m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) AFFORDABLE HEALTH CARE AND COVERAGE. If the federal Patient Protection
5 and Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-148, as amended, under 42 USC 300gg to 300gg-4
6 is no longer enforceable or no longer preempts state law relating to individual or
7 group health insurance policies, no later than the first day of the 13th month
8 beginning after the date the act is no longer enforceable or no longer preempts state
9 law, the department of health services shall submit to the governor a comprehensive
10 strategy to ensure that residents of this state have access to affordable health
11 coverage and health care.”.
