ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 204

September 16, 2019 - Offered by Representatives Thiesfeldt and Hebl.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 5, line 11: after that line insert:

"Section 8m. 755.01 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

755.01 (2) The governing body may by ordinance or bylaw abolish the municipal court as part of a consolidation under s. 66.0229 or at the end of any term for which the judge has been elected or appointed, but only if the ordinance or bylaw abolishing the court is submitted to the appropriate filing office under s. 11.0102 (1) (c) and to the director of state courts prior to October 1 of the year preceding the end of the term for which the judge has been elected or appointed. The governing body may not abolish the municipal court while an agreement under sub. (4) is in effect.".

2. Page 7, line 5: delete "<u>The governing</u>" and substitute "<u>Upon request of the municipal judge, the governing</u>".

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1	3. Page 7, line 5: delete the material beginning with " <u>for</u> " and ending with
2	"judge." on line 6 and substitute "or officer for court sessions.".

- **4.** Page 12, line 3: delete "the costs." and substitute "the costs using the factors in s. 814.29 (1) (d) 1. to 3.".
- **5.** Page 13, line 13: delete "<u>thereafter</u>." and substitute "<u>thereafter</u>. An order lifting a stay may be reviewed by the circuit court at any time following transmittal to the circuit court, upon motion and good cause shown.".
- **6.** Page 16, line 18: delete the material beginning with "<u>mail</u>" and ending with "<u>defendant.</u>" on line 19 and substitute "<u>by mailing it to the defendant at the address on file with the court.</u>".
