**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 101**

February 22, 2022 - Offered by Senator WIMBERGER.

1 **To create** section 7 of article III of the constitution; **relating to:** prohibiting state  
2 and local governments from using privately sourced moneys or equipment in  
3 connection with the conduct of elections and specifying who may perform tasks  
4 related to the conduct of an election (first consideration).

---

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This constitutional amendment, proposed to the 2021 legislature on first consideration, provides that no state agency or officer or employee in state government and no political subdivision of the state or officer or employee of a political subdivision may apply for, accept, expend, or use any moneys or equipment in connection with the conduct of any primary, election, or referendum if the moneys or equipment are donated or granted by an individual or nongovernmental entity. The constitutional amendment also prohibits any individual other than an election official designated by law from performing any task in the conduct of any primary, election, or referendum.

A constitutional amendment requires adoption by two successive legislatures and ratification by the people before it can become effective.
