ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 575

November 14, 2023 - Offered by Representatives Vining, Billings, Conley, Neubauer, Haywood, Madison, Jacobson, Drake, Clancy, Hong, Moore Omokunde, Ratcliff, Palmeri, Emerson, Snodgrass, Sinicki, Ohnstad, Joers, Andraca, Bare, Shelton, Considine, Goyke, Shankland, Cabrera, Ortiz-Velez, Baldeh and Stubbs.

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: delete "the mental" and substitute "school mental".
- 2. Page 1, line 3: delete "training program provided" and substitute "programs administered".
 - **3.** Page 1, line 3: delete "Instruction." and substitute "Instruction and making an appropriation.".
 - **4.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:
- 8 "Section 1g. 20.255 (2) (da) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 9 20.255 (2) (da) Aid for school mental Mental health programs and pupil
 10 wellness aid. The amounts in the schedule for aid to school districts and independent
 11 charter schools employ, hire, and retain pupil services professionals under s.

14	renumbered 115.364 (2) (a) and amended to read:
15	115.364 (2) (a) Beginning in the 2018–19 2024–25 school year and annually
16	thereafter, the state superintendent shall do all of the following: 1. Subject, subject
17	to par. (b), from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (da), pay to an eligible
18	reimburse a school district board, the operator of a charter school established under
19	s. 118.40 (2r) or (2x), or the governing body of a private school participating in a
20	program under s. 118.60 or 119.23 for an amount equal to 50 percent of the amount
21	by which the school district increased its expenditures made by the school board,
22	operator, or governing body in the preceding school year to employ, hire, or retain
23	social workers over the amount it expended in the school year immediately preceding

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1	the preceding school year to employ, hire, or retain social workers pupil services
2	professionals.

10	s. 118.40 (2r) and (2x), and governing bodies of private schools participating in
11	programs under ss. 118.60 and 119.23 that are eligible for the aid.

20	7. Page 3, line 8: delete lines 8 and 9 and substitute:
21	"Section 4m. Fiscal changes.
22	(1) School-based mental health services grants. In the schedule under s.
23	20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of public instruction under s.

20.255 (2) (dt), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2023-24 is increased by

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\$102,914,300. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the
department of public instruction under s. $20.255\ (2)\ (dt)$, the dollar amount for fiscal
year 2024-25 is increased by \$102,914,300.

- (2) Mental Health and Pupil Wellness aid. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of public instruction under s. 20.255 (2) (da), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2023–24 is increased by \$16,500,000. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of public instruction under s. 20.255 (2) (da), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2024–25 is increased by \$18,000,000.
- (3) Mental health training program. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of public instruction under s. 20.255 (1) (ep), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2023–24 is increased by \$500,000 and the dollar amount for fiscal year 2024–25 is increased by \$500,000.

Section 5m. Effective dates. This act takes effect on July 1, 2024, except as follows:

(1) Section 4m of this act takes effect on the day after publication.".
