ORDER

An order of the Dentistry Examining Board to amend DE 2.03 (1) (intro.) and (2) and DE 5.02 (18) relating to the statutory renewal dates for licenses, and to provide the correct citation relating to records which must be kept by dentists for controlled substances.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b) and 227.11 (2), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 440.08 (2) (a) 25. and 26., 447.05 and 447.07 (3) (f), Stats.

This proposed rule-making order of the Dentistry Examining Board makes remedial changes in its rules to bring three separate citations up to date. The statutory renewal date for licenses to practice dentistry and dental hygiene is October 1st of each odd-numbered year, as set forth in s. 440.08 (2) (a) 25. and 26., Stats. Accordingly, s. DE 2.03 (1) and (2) are amended to accurately reflect the renewal dates. Also, pursuant to s. DE 5.02 (18), dentists who purchase, administer or dispense controlled substances are required to comply with certain record keeping and inventory requirements. One of the cited requirements is set forth within the administrative rules of the Pharmacy Examining Board, which now is contained in s. Phar 8.02, as renumbered from Phar 6.02. This change necessitates an updating of the citation within s. DE 5.02 (18).

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. DE 2.03 (1) (intro.) and (2) are amended to read:

DE 2.03 (1) <u>BIENNIAL RENEWAL</u>. (1) REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL; DENTISTS. (intro.) To renew a license a dentist shall, by <u>September 30 October 1</u> of the odd-numbered year following initial licensure and every 2 years thereafter, file with the board:

(2) REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL; DENTAL HYGIENISTS. A dental hygienist shall by September 30 October 1 of the odd-numbered year following initial licensure and every 2 years thereafter, meet requirements for renewal specified in sub. (1) (a) and (b).

SECTION 2. DE 5.02 (18) is amended to read:

DE 5.02 (18) Failing to maintain records and inventories as required by the United States department of justice drug enforcement administration, and under ch. 161, Stats., and s. Phar 6.02 8.02, Wis. Adm. Code.
