## ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

The Wisconsin Natural Resources Board proposes an order to repeal and recreate NR 10.01(1)(b),(g)1.a. to k., (g)2., (g)3., (u)1., (u)2. and (v) relating to the 1998 migratory game bird season.

### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.085, 29.155, 29.174(3), and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085, 29.155, 29.174(1) and (2), Stats.

The proposed rules establish the regulations for the 1998 migratory game bird season. The significant regulations are:

Ducks. The state is divided into two zones each with 60-day seasons. The season in the southern duck zone begins at noon October 3 and continues for 60 days, closing December 1. The north duck zone season begins at noon October 3 and continues through December 1. The daily bag limit in both zones is 6 ducks, including four mallards, of which only one may be a hen, and one canvasback for the entire 60 days in both zones.

Canada Geese. The state is apportioned into 3 Canada goose hunting zones: Horicon, Collins and Exterior. Other special Canada goose management subzones within the Exterior Zone include Brown County, Burnett County, New Auburn, Rock Prairie and the Mississippi River. Season lengths are: Collins Zone - 68 days; Horicon Zone - 86 days; Exterior Zone - 21 days; Mississippi River Subzone - 70 days; Rock Prairie Subzone - 23 days; and Brown County Subzone - 21 days. The Burnett County and New Auburn subzones are closed to Canada goose hunting.

A special youth waterfowl hunt is established that will occur on the 14th day before the opening day of the regular duck season.

SECTION 2. NR 10.01(1)(v) is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.01(1)(v) Special youth waterfowl hunt event. Persons 12 years of age or older but under 16 years of age who possess a certificate of accomplishment under s. 29.225, Stats., may hunt all species of wild duck, mergansers, geese, coots and gallinules on the 14th day before the opening of the regular duck season. Approvals under ch. 29, Stats., are not required pursuant to s. 29.155(1), Stats., except for registration in the harvest information program under s. NR 10.12(11) and a Canada goose hunting permit, if hunting Canada geese. Daily bag limits are those described under s. NR 10.01(1)(b), (c) and (g) and all other waterfowl hunting regulations apply. Hunters shall be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older. One adult may not accompany more than 2 hunters.

The foregoing rules are approved and adopted by the Natural Resources Board on August 26, 1998.

The rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
