ORDER

An order of the Chiropractic Examining Board to renumber Chir 5.01 (1); and to create Chir 3.02 (1) (d), 3.09 and 5.01 (1) (b), (c) and (d), relating to continuing education requirements.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b) and 227.11 (2), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: 446.02 (1) (b), Stats.

In this rule-making order, the Chiropractic Examining Board authorizes the designation of specific topic areas for continuing education. Clarification is made that the continuing education requirement applies in the first full biennium following initial licensure. The board would like to use continuing education to address the areas of greatest need for chiropractors.

Section Chir 3.09 adds the requirement that chiropractors need to maintain certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Chir 3.02 (1) (d) is created to read:

Chir 3.02 (1) (d) Evidence that the licensee is certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

SECTION 2. Chir 3.09 is created to read:

Chir 3.09 Cardiopulmonary resuscitation certification. Every chiropractor shall obtain certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation at least every 2 years.

SECTION 3. Chir 5.01 (1) is renumbered Chir 5.01 (1) (a).

SECTION 4. Chir 5.01 (1) (b), (c) and (d) are created to read:

Chir 5.01 (1) (b) Continuing education requirements for license renewal apply to the first full 2 year period in which a chiropractor is licensed.

(c) Of the 40 continuing education credit hours in par. (a), during the 2-year license registration period from January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2004, every chiropractor shall complete at least 4 continuing education credit hours in radiology.

(d) Of the 40 continuing education credit hours in par. (a), during the 2-year license registration period from January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2004, every chiropractor shall complete at least 4 continuing education hours in ethics, which shall include at least 2 hours in boundary issues.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
