

## ENROLLED JOINT RESOLUTION

**Relating to:** commending the 1995 Green Bay Packers.

Whereas, the 1995 Green Bay Packers won the central division of the National Football Conference; and

Whereas, the Packers then defeated the Atlanta Falcons and the Super Bowl Champion San Francisco Forty-niners in the playoffs, advancing farther than any Packer team since the 1967 world champions; and

Whereas, these accomplishments proved correct the thousands of loyal fans who have been saying for decades that "the Pack will be back"; and

Whereas, the Packers lost by the narrowest of margins to the Dallas Cowboys, and their remarkable season ended one game short of the Super Bowl; and

Whereas, the Packers accomplished these feats partly by creating rare combinations of intelligence and power; exuberance and discipline; and team play and individual brilliance; and

Whereas, this season was also memorable for such individual achievements as Brett Favre's selection as the league's most valuable player; Reggie White's astounding recovery from a serious injury and his selection, along with Brett Favre and Mark Chmura, to the Pro Bowl team; and Robert Brooks's spectacular play; and

Whereas, the effectiveness of dozens of other Packers complemented the work of the Packer stars; and

Whereas, despite their success, the Packers conducted themselves with dignity, allowing for a few exuberant and well-earned leaps into the stands, and class,

demonstrating that they are not only excellent athletes but also excellent human beings, further endearing themselves to their fans; and

Whereas, Head Coach Mike Holmgren, his assistants and the team's administrative staff also performed at a high level; now, therefore, be it
