


WHEREAS, J. Martin Klotsche, Chancellor of the University of Wisconsin - Milwaukee, has informed me that certain rallies beginning today, February 11, 1971, represent a threat to the security of state-owned property in the City of Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, I hereby determine that this rally represents a threat to the security of state-owned property; and

WHEREAS, Chancellor Klotsche has requested that I have twenty-five (25) State Highway Patrolmen made available to the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee pursuant to powers vested in me by Wis. Stats. Section 22.165;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, hereby authorize and request that a total of twenty-five (25) Wisconsin State Highway Patrolmen be made available to the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and that such State Highway Patrolmen shall be assigned to the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee to protect state property in that vicinity during the pendency of the threat to state property.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this 11th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine-hundred and seventy-one.
