



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 81

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of the Municipal Judge for the City of Evansville in the county of Rock, State of Wisconsin, as a result of the resignation of Wilson L. Brown, whose term of office would have expired on April 30, 1982;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the existing vacancy, be held;

AND, if nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the circulation of nomination papers, then the Special Election shall be held on October 13, 1981. The circulation of nominating papers for candidates may commence on July 29, 1981, the deadline for filing nomination papers for candidates shall be 5:00 P.M., August 18, 1981. The special primary shall be held on September 15, 1981.

AND, if nomination for such office is to be accomplished by a nominating caucus, then the nominating caucus shall be held in accordance with Section 8.05(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes on or before August 18, 1981, and the Special Election shall be held on October 13, 1981.

AND, the election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.

FURTHER, I hereby declare that this Executive Order No. 81, supercedes Executive Order No. 80, issued July 16, 1981.
