

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 97

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Municipal Judge for the City of Lake Geneva in the County of Walworth, State of Wisconsin, as a result of the death of The Honorable Emil H. Johnejack, whose term of office would have expired on May 1, 1985;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Wisconsin Statutes Section 8.50, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the existing vacancy be held:

AND, if nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the circulation of nomination papers, then the Special Election shall be held on November 2, 1982. circulation of nominating papers for candidates may commence on July 28, 1982, the deadline for filing nomination papers for candidates shall be 5:00 p.m., August 17, 1982. The special primary shall be held on September 14, 1982.

AND, if nomination for such office is to be accomplished by a nominating caucus, then the nominating caucus shall be held in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes Section 8.05(1) on or before August 17, 1982, and the Special Election shall be held on November 2, 1982.

AND, the election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
