
Relating to a Special Election for the
First Congressional District

WHEREAS, United States Congressman Les Aspin submitted his resignation as a United States Congressman for the First Congressional District, effective January 20, 1993 at 5:05 p.m. to become United States Secretary of Defense.


NOW, THEREFORE, I TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 8.50 and Article I, section 2 of the United States Constitution order that a special election be held on May 4, 1993 to fill the vacancy in the First Congressional District as described in Wisconsin Statute section 3.01 for a term expiring at noon on the third day of January, 1995, and that if a primary is necessary, it shall be held on April 6, 1993. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin after the issuance of this order and shall be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., March 9, 1993. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
