EXECUTIVE ORDER #215

Relating to the Creation of the
Governor's Milwaukee Stadium Commission

WHEREAS, maintaining a high quality major league sports stadium in metropolitan Milwaukee is a priority for the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a new sports stadium is essential to maintaining the Milwaukee Brewers as a viable franchise in Wisconsin; and

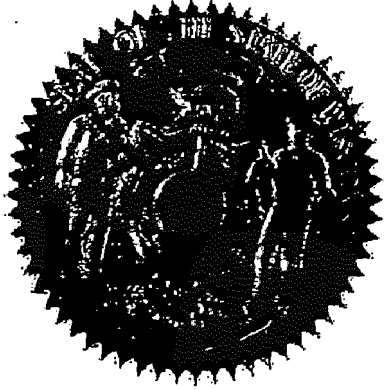
WHEREAS, the construction of a new sports stadium in Milwaukee is important to the future of the Green Bay Packers; and

WHEREAS, all options should be thoroughly evaluated before any financial steps are recommended or taken;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 14.019, do hereby:

1. Establish the Governor's Milwaukee Stadium Commission.
2. Provide that the Commission shall be appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure and will represent the private sector, state government and local government. The chairperson will be appointed by the Governor from the private sector.
3. Direct the Commission to:
 - a. Review the infrastructure and construction funding methods used in other cities that have built new sports stadiums recently.
 - b. Review funding options that may be used to fund such stadiums.
 - c. Examine combinations of funding methods that might be appropriate for use in Wisconsin to fund a new stadium in Milwaukee.
 - d. Submit a summary report with recommendations to the Governor by February 1, 1995.

4. Direct the Secretary of the Department of Administration, in cooperation with and complimented by private sector resources, to provide all necessary staff resources for the Commission.
