EXECUTIVE ORDER #235

Relating to Calling to Active Service
the Wisconsin National Guard

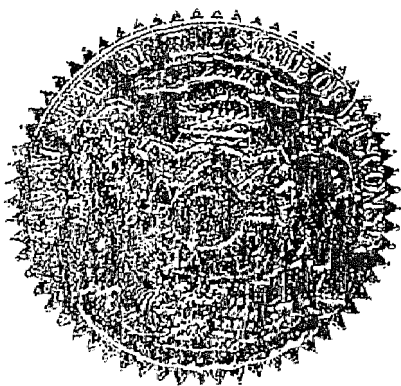
WHEREAS, Terri Jacobus has been determined to be missing; and

WHEREAS, on September 11 Sheriff William Fillbach of Crawford County requested the Governor to authorize use of a National Guard helicopter to assist in the search; and


WHEREAS, the needs of Crawford County cannot be met with local resources,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 21.11, do hereby:

Call to active service and direct the Wisconsin National Guard to assist in locating Terri Jacobus and direct the Adjutant General and/or designee to deploy such personnel and equipment as may be necessary.
