EXECUTIVE ORDER #251

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

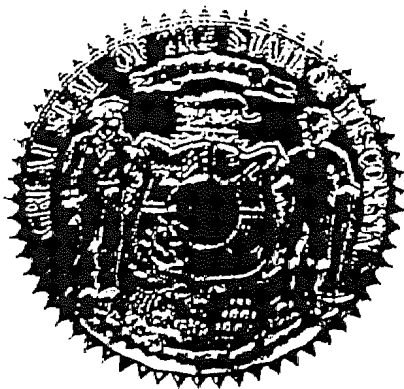
WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department reported a missing person from Jefferson County, Wisconsin on or about June 6, 1995, and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Sheriff requested assistance from the Wisconsin National Guard, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute § 14.019, do hereby:

Declare a State of Emergency, effective June 12, 1995, in Jefferson County and direct the Wisconsin National Guard and the Division of Emergency Government to assist the Jefferson County Sheriff in taking whatever actions within the state that are necessary to aid in the search for said missing person.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twelfth day of June in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-five.
