EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 402

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Sergeant Todd J. Stamper of the Crandon Police Department

WIHEREAS, on the afternoon of July 15, 2000, Sergeant Todd J. Stamper of the Crandon Police Department died in the line of duty; and

WIHEREAS, Sergeant Stamper bravely and honorably served the people of the City of Crandon, Forest County and the State of Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on July 21, 2000 and ending at sunset on that date;

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this nineteenth day of July in the year two thousand.
