EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 15

Relating to the Amendment of Executive Order No. 14

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was declared in Executive Order No. 14 for Outagamie and Winnebago counties in the State of Wisconsin due to damage caused by severe thunderstorms and high winds starting on or about June 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Barron, Calumet, Polk, Portage, Rusk, Waupaca, Waushara and Wood counties were also severely impacted by these extremely severe thunderstorms and high winds; and

WHEREAS, such severe storms caused extensive damage to residential and commercial properties, agriculture, the power distribution system and other elements of the public service infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, additional personnel and resources are needed to expedite emergency recovery operations in Barron, Calumet, Outagamie, Polk, Portage, Rusk, Waupaca, Waushara, Winnebago and Wood counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, and specifically by Sections 21.11 (1) and 166.03 (1)(b) 1 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

- Proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Barron, Calumet, Polk, Portage, Rusk, Waupaca, Waushara and Wood counties; and
- Direct all agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist said counties; 2.
- Call to active duty such elements of the Wisconsin National Guard 3. as the Adjutant General deems necessary to expedite emergency recovery operations; and
- Authorize the Adjutant General to use personnel called to active 4 duty pursuant to this order in emergency status.
