EXECUTIVE ORDER # 9


Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Fire Chief Edward Weber of the Elkhart Lake Fire Department

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2003, Fire Chief Edward Weber died while battling a fire in Sheboygan County; and

WHEREAS, Fire Chief Edward Weber served the people of Elkhart Lake and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Fire Chief Edward Weber; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Thursday, April 17, 2003, and ending at sundown on that date.
