

EXECUTIVE ORDER #259

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Former Representative Gerald Daniel "Jerry" Kleczka of the 4th Congressional District

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2017, Representative Gerald Daniel "Jerry" Kleczka passed away at the age of 73; and

WHEREAS, Representative Jerry Kleczka served in the United States House of Representatives from 1984 to 2005, representing the people of Wisconsin's 4th Congressional District; and

WHEREAS, as a member of the House of Representatives, Representative Jerry Kleczka served on the House Committee on Ways and Means and the House Committee on the Budget; and

WHEREAS, before his election to the United States House of Representatives in 1984, Representative Jerry Kleczka served in the Wisconsin State Assembly from 1969 to 1974 and also in the Wisconsin State Senate from 1975 to 1984; and

WHEREAS, Representative Jerry Kleczka was a dedicated public servant, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his passing; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Representative Jerry Kleczka on Saturday, October 14, 2017;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, October 14, 2017,** and ending at sunset on that date.
