EXECUTIVE ORDER #286

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Spooner Fire District Firefighter Philip Neubich

WHEREAS, on Wednesday, April 25, 2018, Philip Neubich, a volunteer firefighter with the Spooner Fire District, died in the line of duty after suffering a heart attack shortly after responding to a call; and

WHEREAS, Philip Neubich was a volunteer firefighter and a valued member of his community, serving the Spooner area as a volunteer firefighter for more than 38 years; and


WHEREAS, Philip Neubich leaves behind an honorable legacy of public service, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, a funeral service will be held for Philip Neubich in Spooner, Wisconsin, on Monday, April 30, 2018;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on **Monday, April 30, 2018**, and ending at sunset on that date.
