EXECUTIVE ORDER #26

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Firefighter Mitchell F. Lundgaard of the Appleton Fire Department

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2019, Firefighter Mitchell F. Lundgaard of the Appleton Fire Department died in the line of duty;

WHEREAS, Firefighter Mitchell F. Lundgaard was a member of the Appleton Fire Department for 14 years;

WHEREAS, Firefighter Mitchell F. Lundgaard dedicated his life and career to protecting the people of the Fox River Valley and Wisconsin;

WHEREAS, Firefighter Mitchell F. Lundgaard was a devoted husband, loving father to his three sons, and a valued member of his community; and

WHEREAS, Firefighter Mitchell F. Lundgaard leaves behind an honorable legacy of service to his community and his state, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, **beginning immediately and ending at sunset on the date of interment.**
