A fraternal benefit society may provide insurance benefits to its members and employees. Various requirements must be complied with in order to be considered a fraternal benefit society, including a requirement that the organization have a lodge system as defined in the statutes, including having a supreme governing body and local lodges.

2003 Wisconsin Act 60 changes the requirement that each local lodge hold regular meetings at least monthly to a requirement that such meetings be held at least *once every three months*.
