

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

Wisconsin Act 166 makes the following changes in laws relating to snowmobiles:

- 1. Provides that a person operating a snowmobile on or adjacent to a roadway must observe the roadway speed limit, unless the person is operating the vehicle as part of a snowmobile special event authorized by the local government that has jurisdiction over the roadway.
- 2. Exempts snowmobile accidents that occur during snowmobile races or derbies sponsored by specified entities from general procedures that must otherwise be followed in the event of a snowmobile accident.
- 3. Prohibits a person from knowingly interfering with the proper operation of a snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle (ATV) odometer. The Act also prohibits a person, with intent to defraud, from interfering with the proper operation of an hour meter on a snowmobile, ATV or boat (the meter measures and records the hours a vehicle has been operating). The Act contains exceptions to allow a malfunctioning odometer or hour meter to be restored to proper working order. A person violating the provision relating to hour meters may be fined not more than \$5,000 or imprisoned for not more than one year in the county jail, or both, for each violation.
- 4. Provides that operators of snowmobiles proceeding in opposite directions must proceed with caution and pass each other to the right.

Effective Date: The Act takes effect on April 20, 2004.
