**Ratification of Collective
Bargaining Agreement: Technical**

2005 Wisconsin Act 20 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, for the 2003-05 Biennium, covering employees in the technical collective bargaining unit. The technical unit consists of approximately 3,699 full-time equivalent positions and includes pilots, barbers, chemists, dental hygienists, diagnostic radiologic technicians, electronics technicians, engineering technicians, fingerprint technicians, grain inspectors, histology technicians, network technicians, lab technicians, morticians, physical and occupational therapy assistants, pharmacy technicians, property assessment technicians, and others.

Effective Date: The general effective date of 2005 Wisconsin Act 20 is July 23, 2005. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 20 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the technical collective bargaining unit.
