2005 Wisconsin Act 402 [2005 Senate Bill 486]	Income Continuation Insurance Errors (Remedial Legislation)
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2005 Wisconsin Act 402 is an enactment of a bill introduced by the Law Revision Committee as remedial legislation requested by the Department of Employee Trust Funds (DETF).

The Act provides that if an eligible employee has failed to meet the criteria for coverage under the income continuation coverage program, which is administered by DETF, because of employer error, the employee may become insured by filing a new application within 30 days after the employee received from the employer written notice of the error. Coverage begins on the first day of the first month beginning after the date on which the employer receives the new application and upon approval by DETF.
