

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 141 [2007 Assembly Bill 616]

Remedial Legislation [Department of Health and Family Services]

This legislation was suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Health and Family Services and introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., Stats.

2007 Wisconsin Act 141 corrects statutory references to the U.S. Code for the Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly. The corrected references reflect that the program is no longer a Medical Assistance waiver program but is now administered under the Medical Assistance program without the need for a waiver.
