2007 Wisconsin Act 6 [2007 Senate Bill 55]

Designating Bridge as Veterans Memorial Bridge

Under *current law*, certain highway routes and bridges have been designated and marked to memorialize, commemorate, or recognize certain individuals, groups, or events.

2007 Wisconsin Act 6 directs the Department of Transportation to designate and, upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, mark the 4th Street bridge across the Wisconsin River in the City of Tomahawk as "Veterans Memorial Bridge," as a living memorial to and in honor of all Wisconsin veterans, living and dead, of all wars in which the United States has engaged.

No state funds, other than from contributions from interested parties, may be used for the erection or maintenance of any marker to identify the bridge as "Veterans Memorial Bridge."
