

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 7 [2007 Assembly Bill 123]

Frequency of Wage Payments to Volunteer Firefighters and EMTs

Current law generally requires an employer to pay an employee's wages no later than 31 days after the date on which the wages are earned, with exceptions for certain employees, including those engaged in logging or farm labor or those covered by a collective bargaining agreement establishing a different payment frequency.

2007 Wisconsin Act 7 creates an additional exception for volunteer firefighters and volunteer emergency medical technicians who, by agreement with their employers, are paid semiannually or annually.
