

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 88 [2007 Senate Bill 324]

Remedial Legislation [Department of Health and Family Services]

This legislation was suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) and introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., Stats.

2007 Wisconsin Act 88 repeals the current requirement that DHFS award \$100,000 annually to a "nurse-managed community health center in a first class city." There is no longer any nurse-managed community health center in a first class city.
