

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 91 [2007 Senate Bill 327]

Remedial Legislation [Department of Health and Family Services]

This legislation was suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Health and Family Services and introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., Stats.

2007 Wisconsin Act 91 eliminates the definition of the term "lead inspection" and replaces that term with the term "lead investigation" in pertinent statutes that currently refer to lead inspections. ("Lead investigation," defined in s. 254.11 (8s), Stats., is a broader term that encompasses "lead inspection.")
