

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 37 [2009 Senate Bill 39]

Cash Value of Life Insurance Under Veterans Assistance Program

The Veterans Assistance Program provides limited financial assistance payments to needy veterans and eligible family members, to be used for specified health care or other subsistence needs. Current program rules limit eligibility to applicants whose liquid assets, including bank accounts, stocks, funds in retirement accounts, and the cash value of life insurance, do not exceed \$1,000.

Wisconsin Act 37 exempts the first \$50,000 of the cash value of life insurance from being considered in determining whether a veteran or family member is eligible for assistance under the program.
