2009 Wisconsin Act 43 [2009 Assembly Bill 319]

Regional Structural Collapse Teams

2009 Wisconsin Act 43 resulted from enactment of 2009 Assembly Bill 319. That bill was introduced by the Joint Legislative Council based on the recommendations of the Special Committee on Emergency Management and Continuity of Government. Act 43 puts in place statutes governing regional teams established to respond to structural collapse emergencies. The Act directs the Division of Emergency Management ("division") to contract with local agencies to establish no more than four regional structural collapse teams.

The Act provides that a team that responds to a structural collapse incident must make a good faith effort to identify the person responsible for the collapse and provide that information to the division. The division collects money from the responsible person and reimburses the team for costs incurred in responding to the incident. Reimbursement is limited to the amount of money collected by the division from a responsible person.

Effective date: Act 43 takes effect on October 21, 2009.
