2019 Wisconsin Act 27 [2019 Assembly Bill 22]

Driver Education Instruction on Human Trafficking

Current law directs the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) Board and the Department of Transportation (DOT) to approve a driver's education program only if certain requirements are met. The act requires that technical college and DOT-licensed private driver schools offering a commercial motor vehicle driver education course provide instruction in the recognition and prevention of human trafficking. The act also requires that the Department of Justice, in consultation with the WTCS Board and the DOT, identify and establish industry-specific materials for use in the required instruction on human trafficking by no later than June 30, 2021.

Effective date: November 22, 2019. The act first applies to driver education courses that begin on the effective date.
