Current law specifies certain requirements for the design of vehicle registration plates issued by the Department of Transportation (DOT), including the special group vehicle registration plates issued to persons awarded the Purple Heart Medal under s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 32., Stats.

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 adds to these a requirement that the DOT specify, with written approval by the Department of Veterans Affairs, one combination of colors and design that includes display of the words “combat-wounded veteran” for the special group vehicle registration plate issued to persons awarded the Purple Heart Medal.

Legislative History

On May 23, 2003, the Senate Committee on Homeland Security, Veterans and Military Affairs and Government Reform introduced and recommended for adoption Senate Substitute Amendment 1 by a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0, and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
