2007 Assembly Bill 590

Assembly Amendment 1

Assembly Bill 590 authorizes a sheriff (or undersheriff), subject to approval by the adjutant general, to depute a security officer employed by the Department of Military Affairs to provide protection for federal personnel, property, and assets located at military installations and air bases in the state.

Assembly Amendment 1 provides that:

- 1. The deputed person may protect *state*, as well as federal personnel, property, and assets.
- 2. The personnel, property, and assets to be protected may be located at *or near* military installations or air bases and include *any aircraft conducting air operations at or near* such installations or bases.
- 3. The sheriff must specify in writing the jurisdiction of a deputed officer.

Legislative History

In executive session on December 4, 2007, the Assembly Committee on Homeland Security and State Preparedness voted to introduce and adopt Assembly Amendment 1, and to recommend passage of the bill as amended, on votes of Ayes, 7; and Noes, 1.

On December 11, 2007, the Assembly adopted Assembly Amendment 1 and passed the bill, as amended, both on voice votes.
