Assembly Bill 828

2007 Assembly Bill 828 would change the definition of "bicycle" to include vehicles propelled by the rider's hands and would allow the use of any color of light on the rear of a bicycle, motor bicycle, or Segway. The bill would also allow a bicyclist to use hand signals and arm signals for turns and stops with either hand or arm.

Assembly Amendment 1

Assembly Amendment 1 allows the use of red light to the rear of a bicycle instead of a red reflector.

Legislative History

Assembly Amendment 1 was introduced by Representative Davis. The Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of Assembly Bill 828, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 12; Noes, 0.
