Senate Amendment 1

Senate Bill 274 prohibits an employee of a local governmental unit (generally counties) who has responsibilities related to the regulation of private sewage systems from either performing soil testing or installing, maintaining, repairing, designing, or selling private sewage systems.

Senate Amendment 1 creates an exception to these prohibitions for activities performed by such an employee on property owned by the employee that is outside of the governmental unit for which the employee works.

Legislative History

Senator Miller offered Senate Amendment 1 on November 30, 2007. On December 4, 2007, the Senate Committee on Environmental Resources adopted Senate Amendment 1 and recommended passage of Senate Bill 274, as amended, by separate votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
