



WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

2011 Assembly Bill 608

Assembly Amendment 1

Under *current law*, the Council on Highway Safety (“the Council”) consists of 15 members. The members of the council include three representatives to the Assembly and two Senators, each of whom must serve on a standing committee dealing with transportation matters.

2011 Assembly Bill 608 eliminates the requirement that the Senators and Representatives that are appointed to the Council must serve on a standing committee dealing with transportation matters.

Assembly Amendment 1 requires that at least one of the three Representatives, and at least one of the two Senators, who are members of the Council must serve on a standing committee dealing with transportation matters.

Legislative History

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by the Assembly Committee on Transportation. On February 28, 2012, the Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 12; Noes, 0. The committee then recommended passage of Assembly Bill 608, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 12; Noes, 0.
