**2011 Assembly Bill 64**

Current law imposes an indivisibility requirement on single trip permits for the transport of oversize loads containing mobile homes, manufactured homes, and modular homes or their components. An oversize permit can only be issued for a single article that cannot be reasonably divided. Assembly Bill 64 permits the Department of Transportation to issue a permit for the transport of more than one section of a mobile home, manufactured home, or modular home on a single carrier, provided that all sections are components of the same home.

**Assembly Amendment 1**

Assembly Amendment 1 allows issuance of these permits only if at least one component of a divisible load would have required an oversize permit if transported individually.

**Legislative History**

The Assembly Committee on Transportation introduced Assembly Amendment 1 and recommended adoption of the amendment by a vote of Ayes, 15; Noes, 0. The committee recommended passage of Assembly Bill 64, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 15; Noes, 0.

The Assembly adopted Assembly Amendment 1 by a voice vote. The Assembly passed Assembly Bill 64 by a voice vote.
