2013 Senate Bill 515 modifies provisions of the Wisconsin Administrative Code promulgated by the Accounting Examining Board to incorporate by reference certain rules of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

Senate Amendment 1 adds a provision specifying, in the statutes, that a person is not eligible to take the examination for certification as a public accountant unless that person has completed at least 120 semester hours of specified education.

Senate Amendment 2 adds provisions needed to accomplish the original intent of the authors.

Bill History

2013 Senate Bill 515 was introduced by Senator Grothman and others on January 24, 2014. Senate Amendments 1 and 2 were offered by Senator Grothman on February 12, 2014.

On February 13, 2014, the Senate Committee on Government Operations, Public Works, and Telecommunications voted to recommend adoption of Senate Amendments 1 and 2 and to recommend passage of Senate Bill 515, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 7; and Noes, 0.
